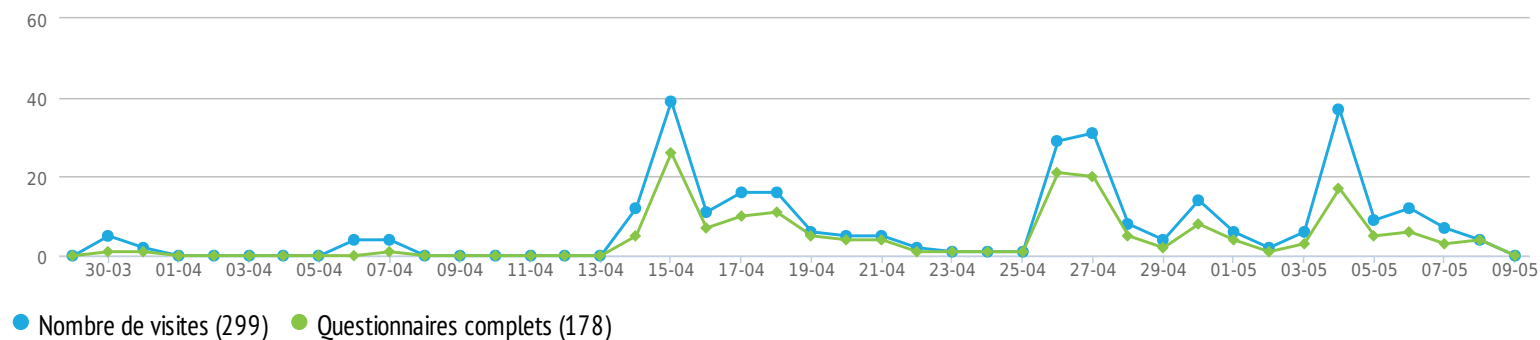

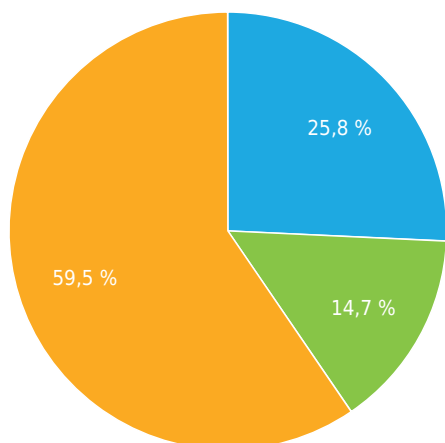

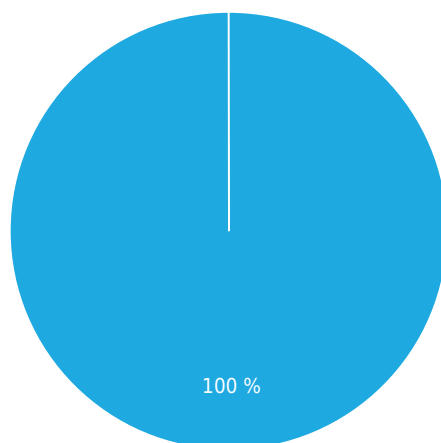

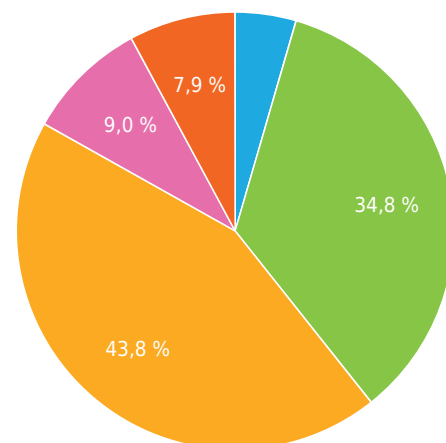

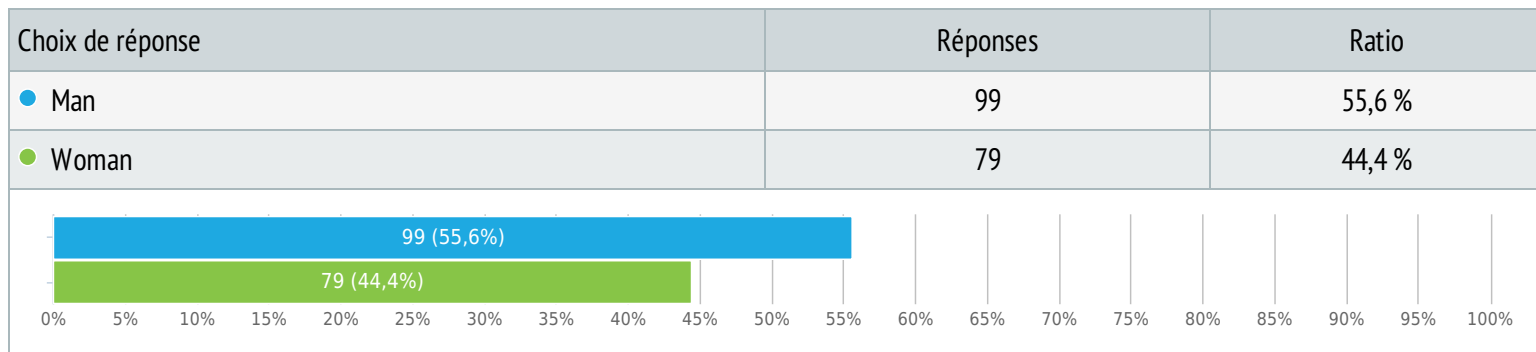

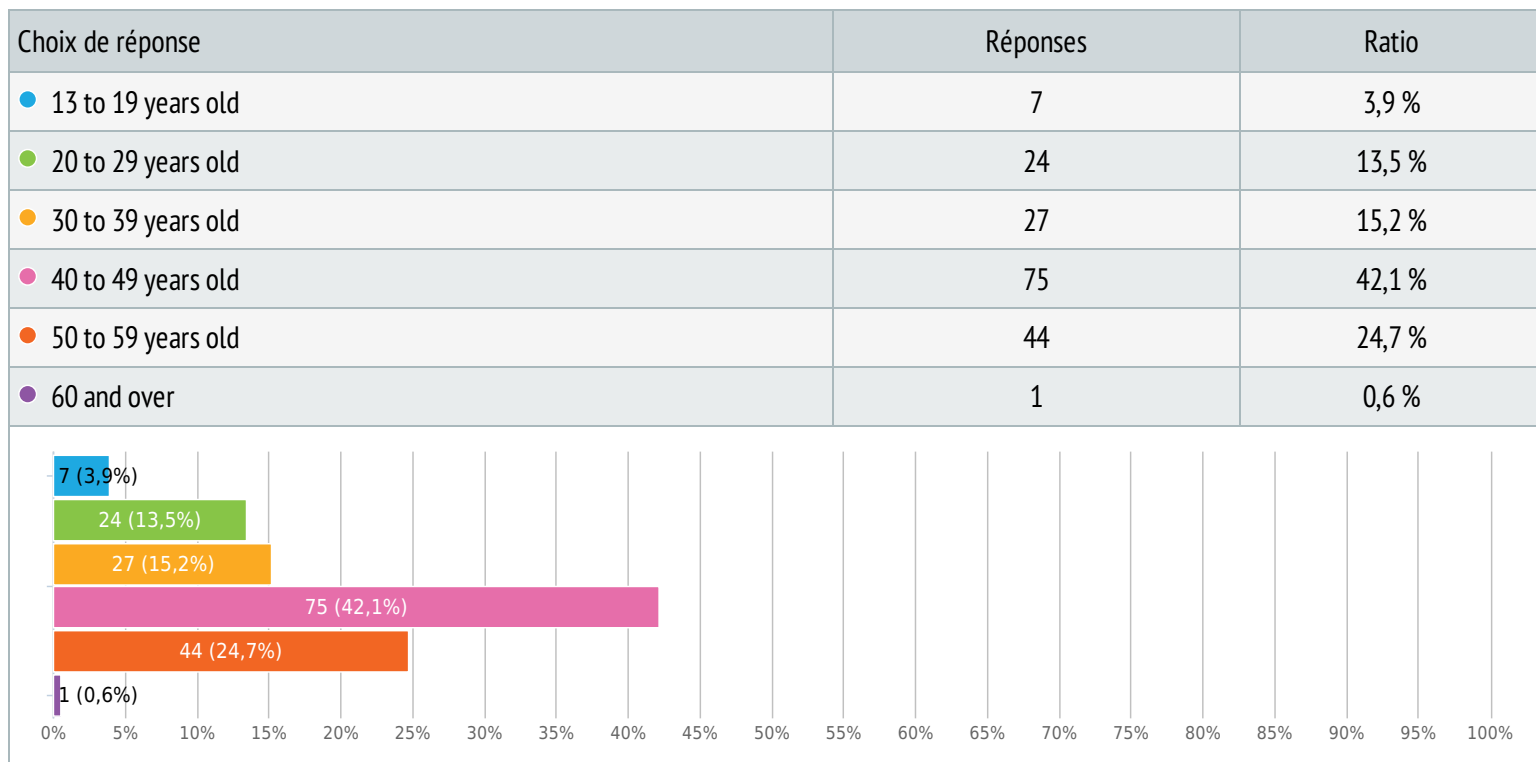

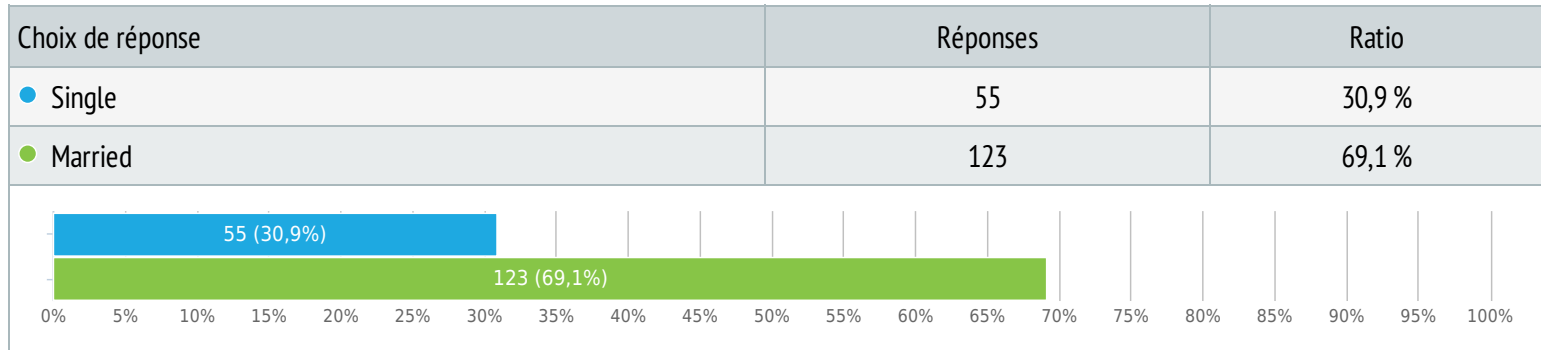

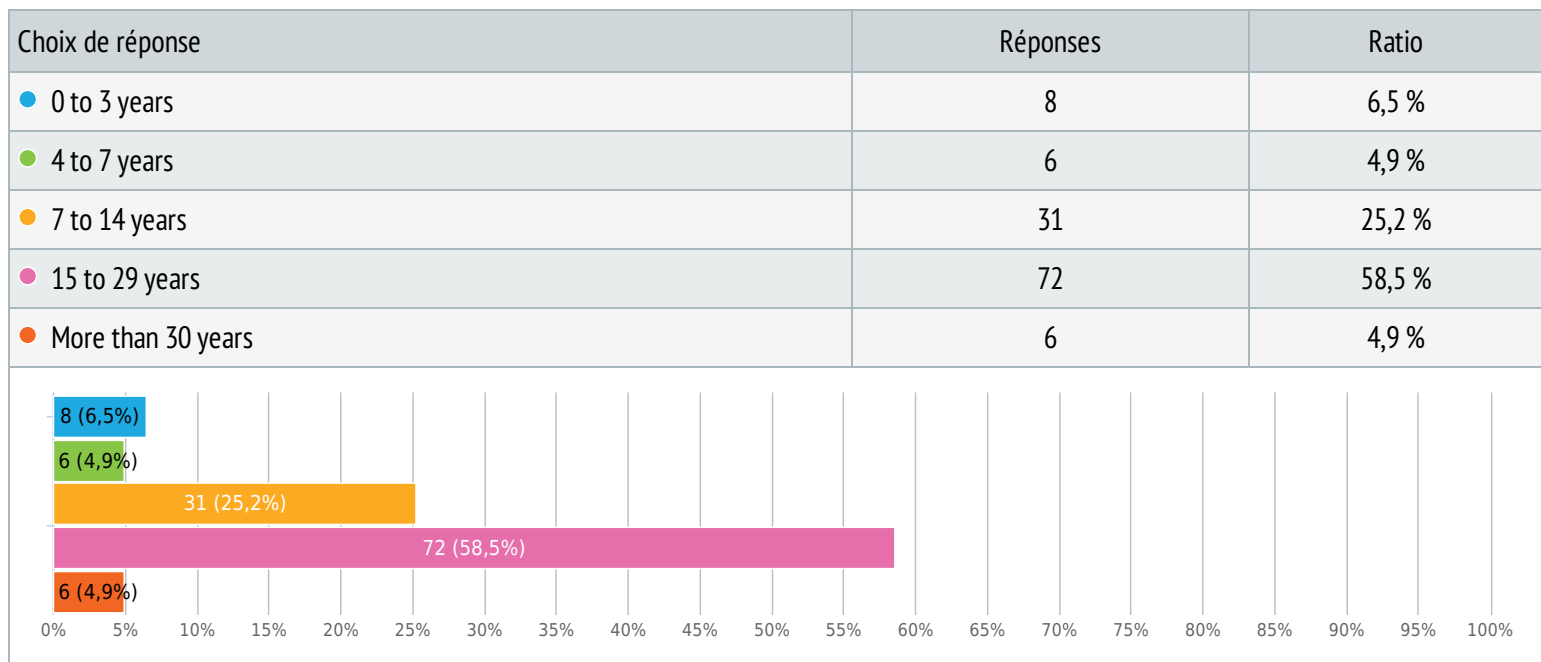

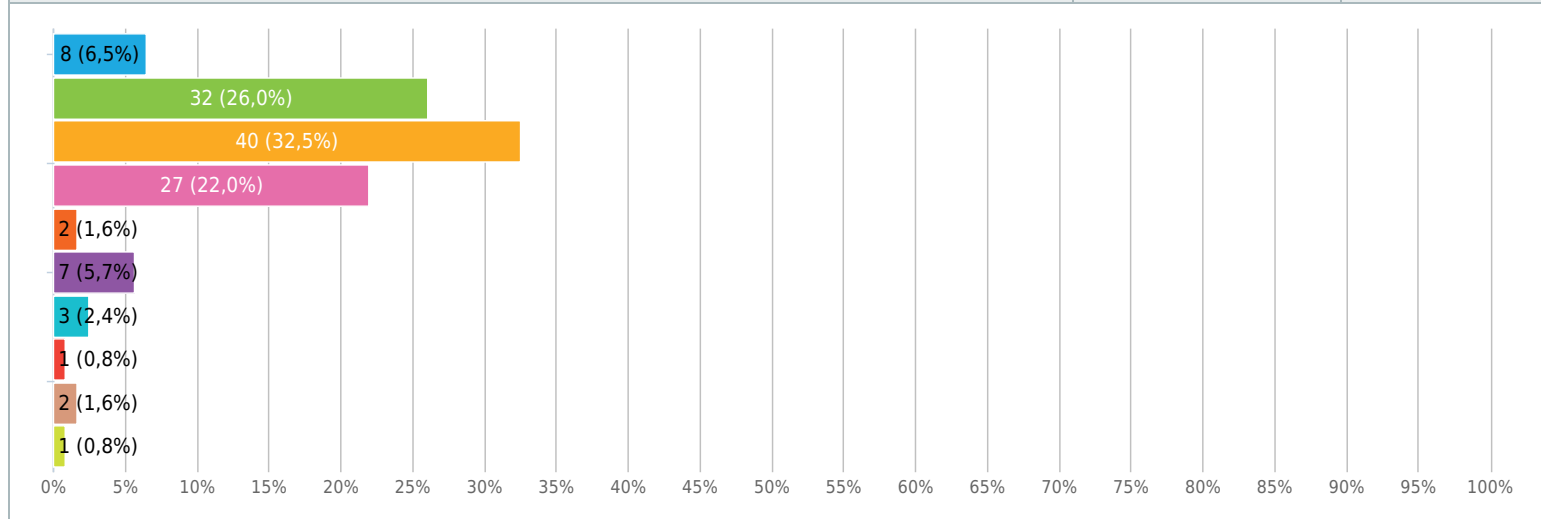

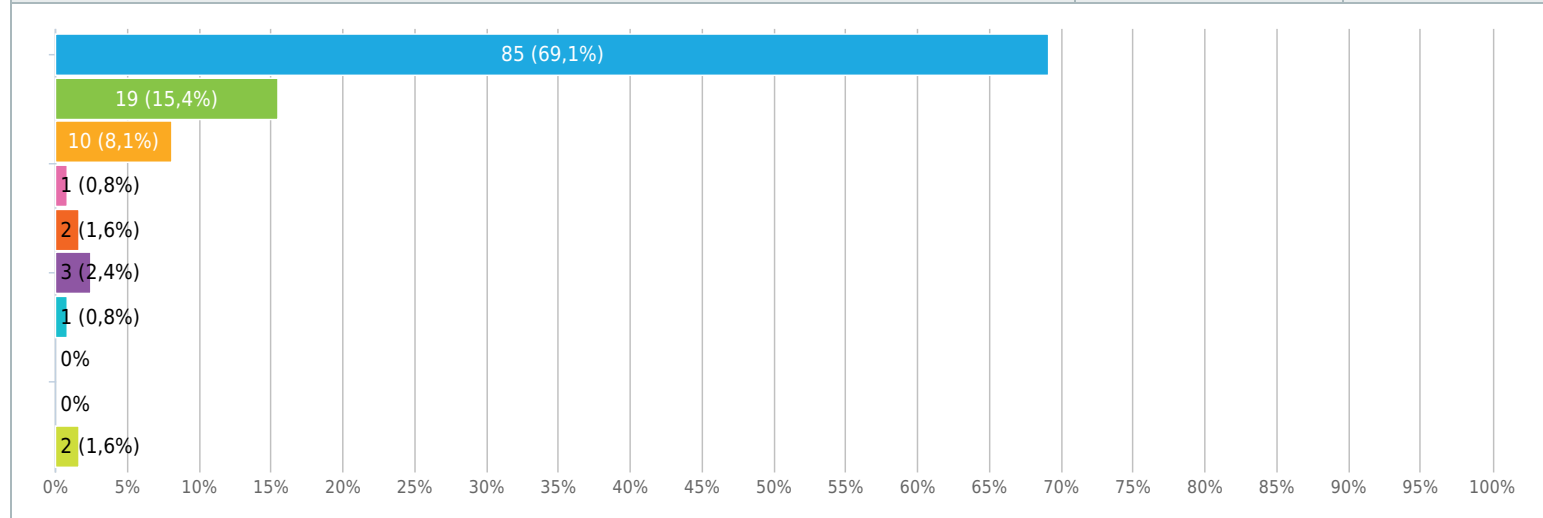

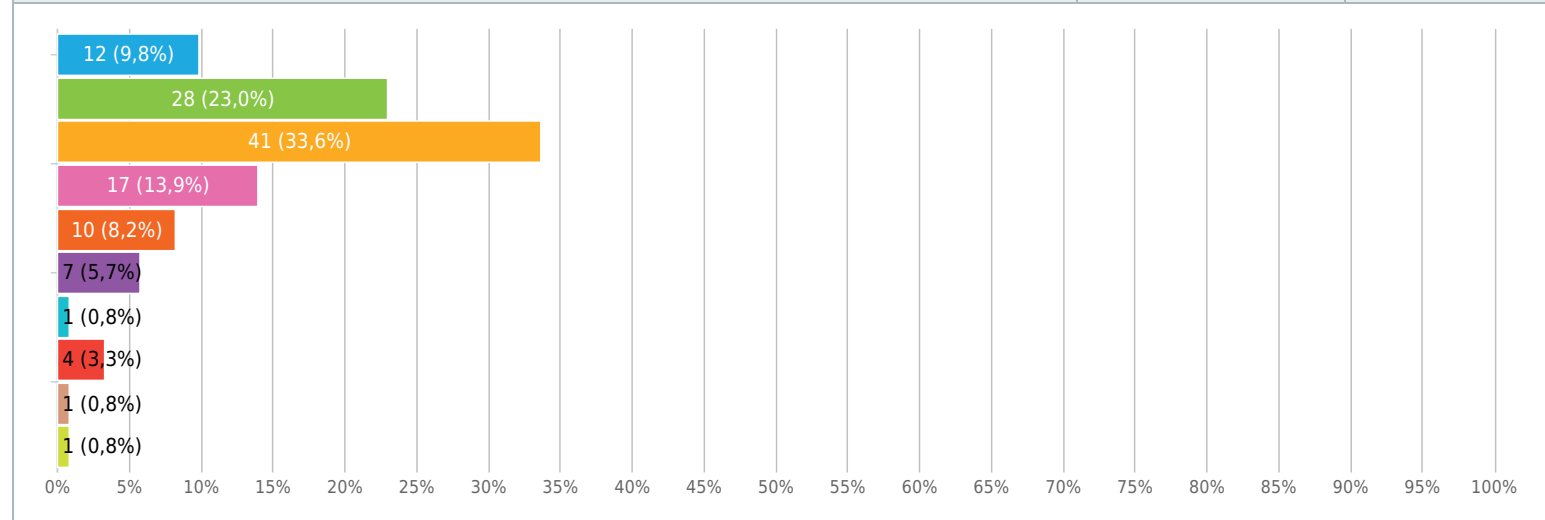

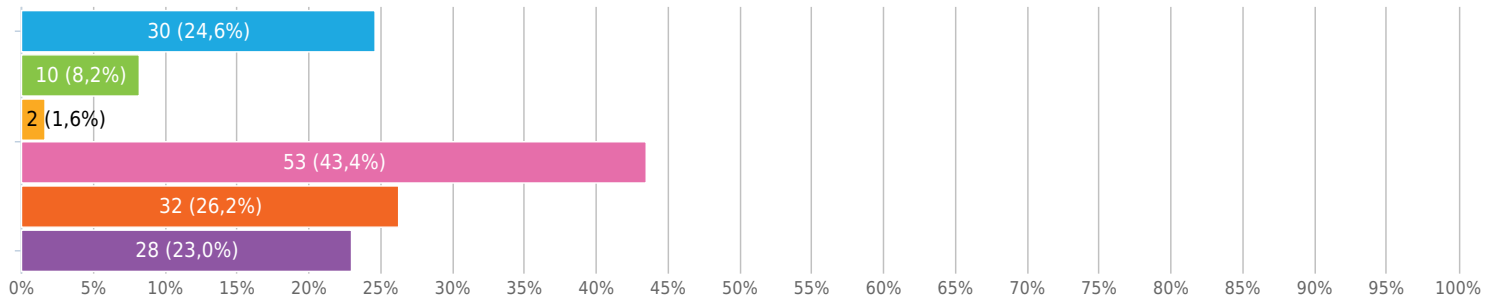

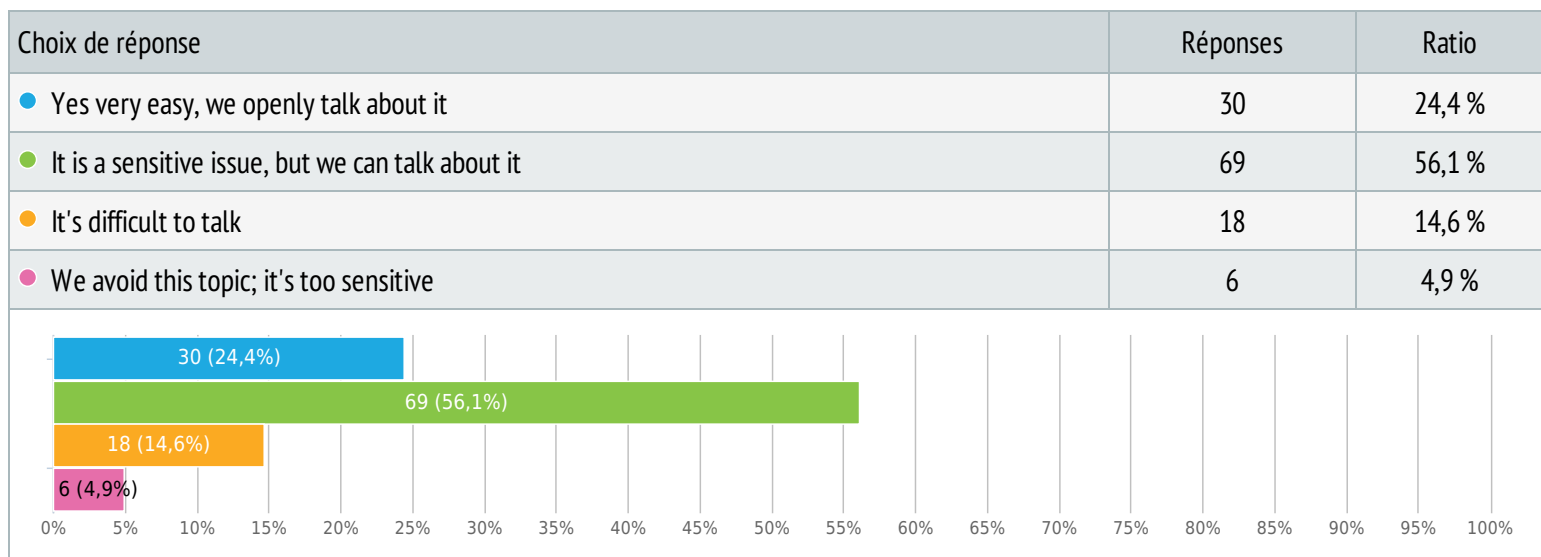

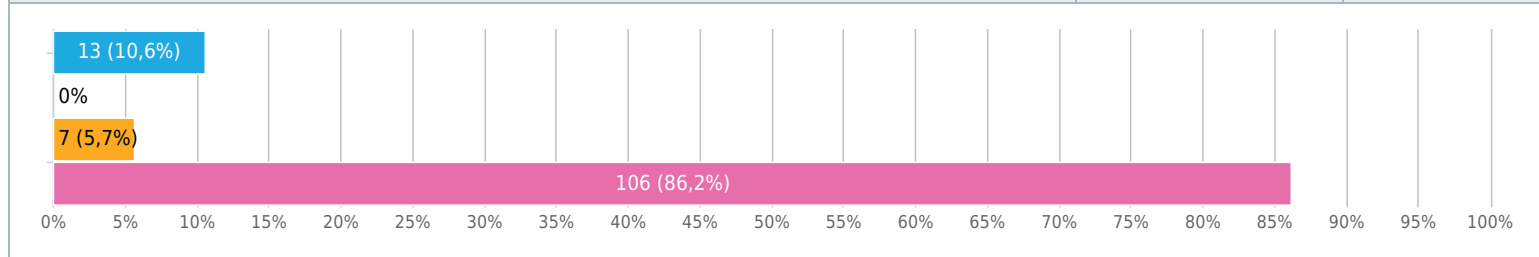

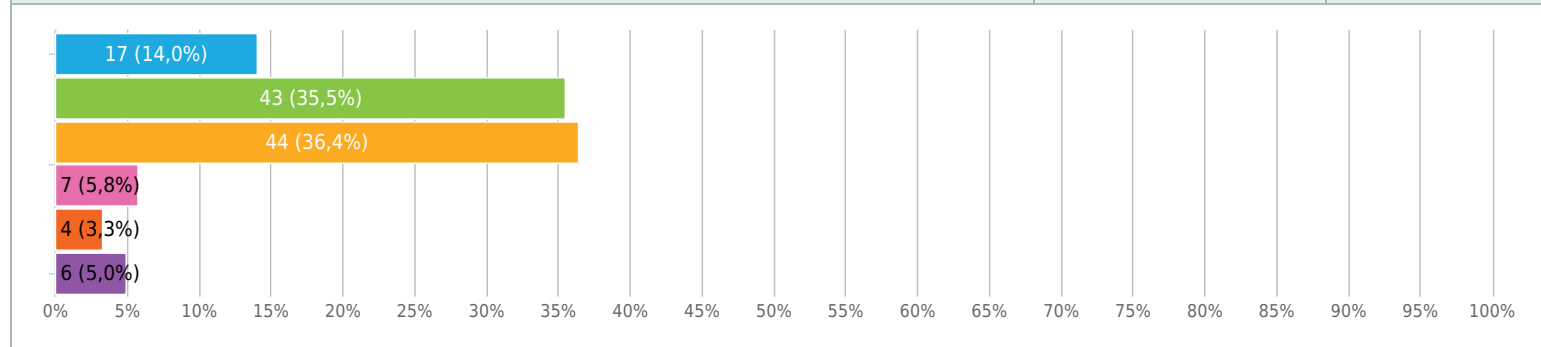

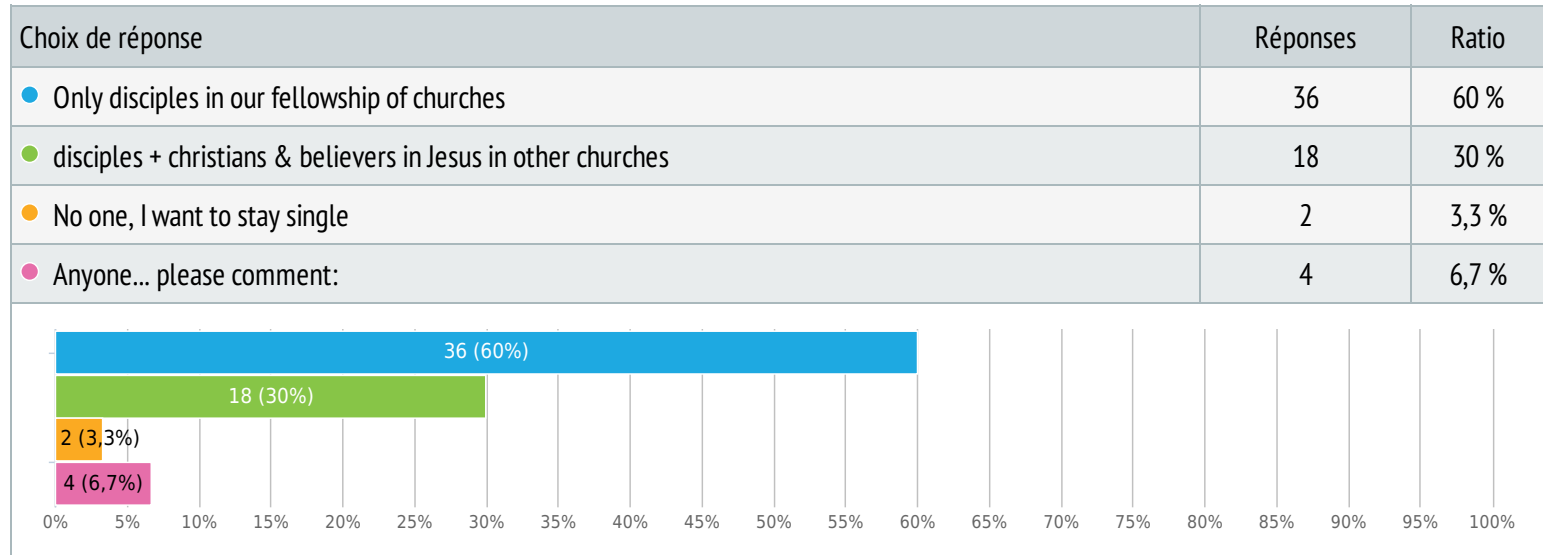

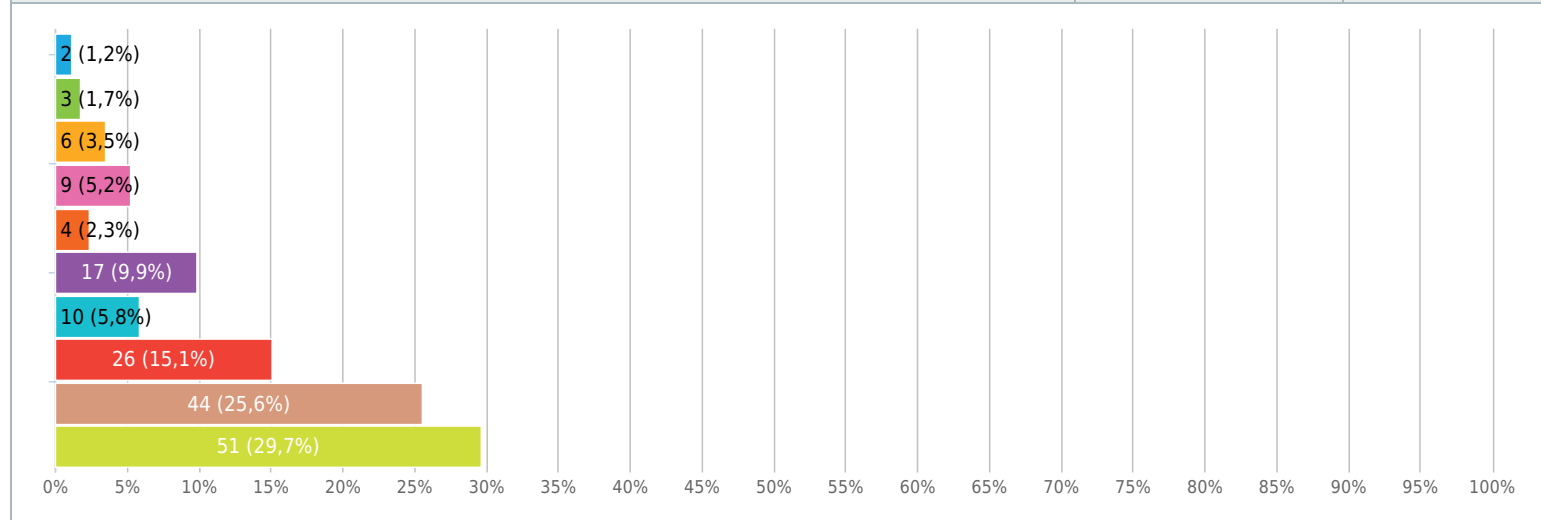

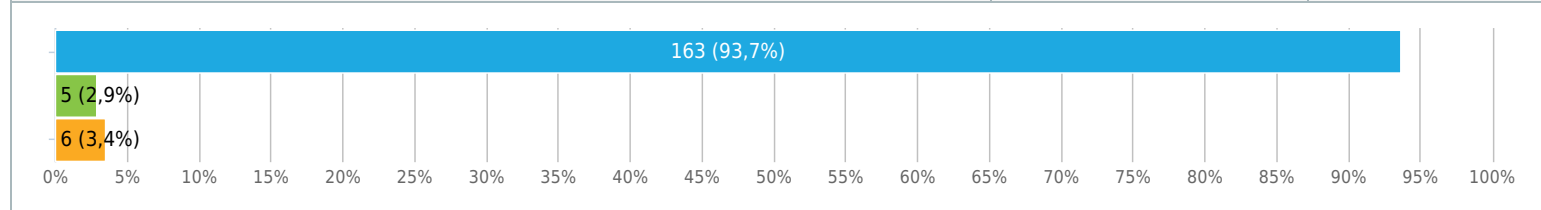

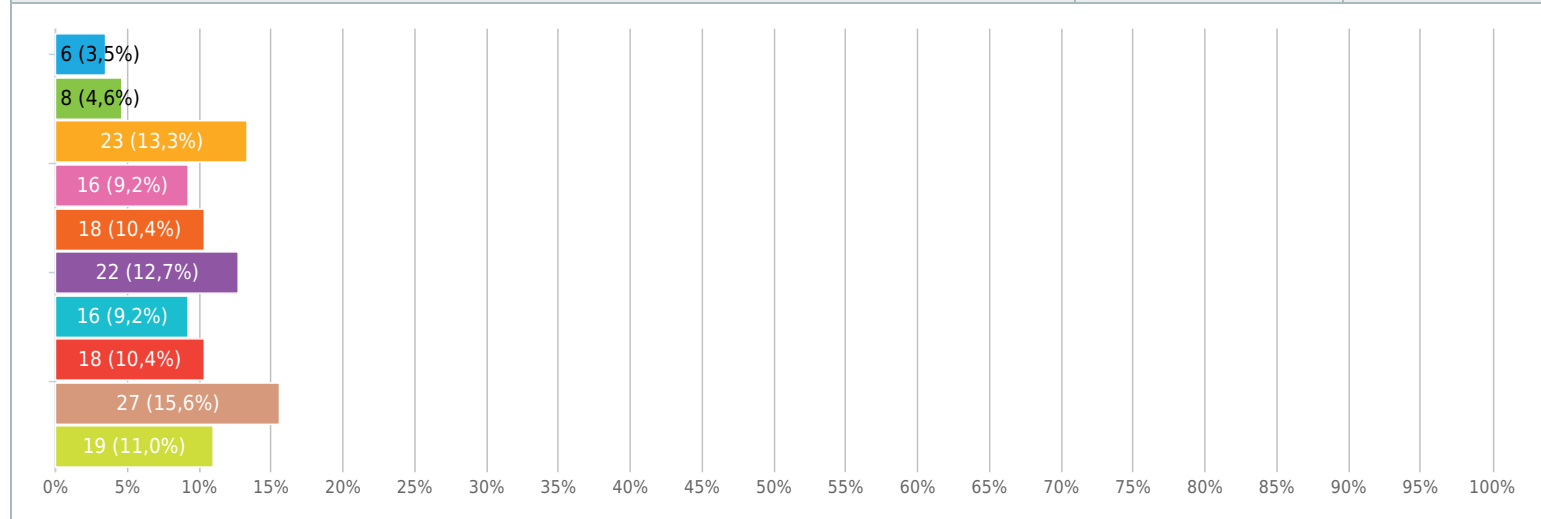

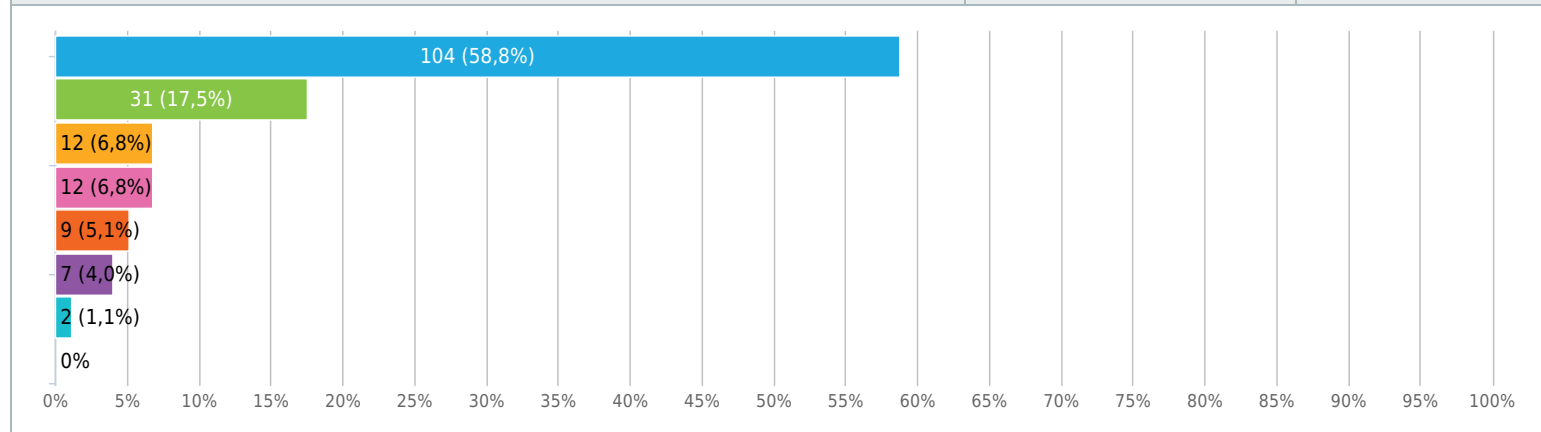

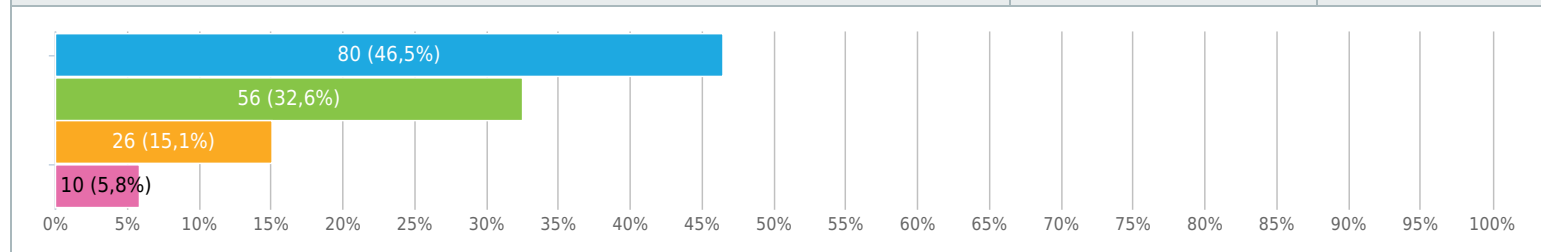

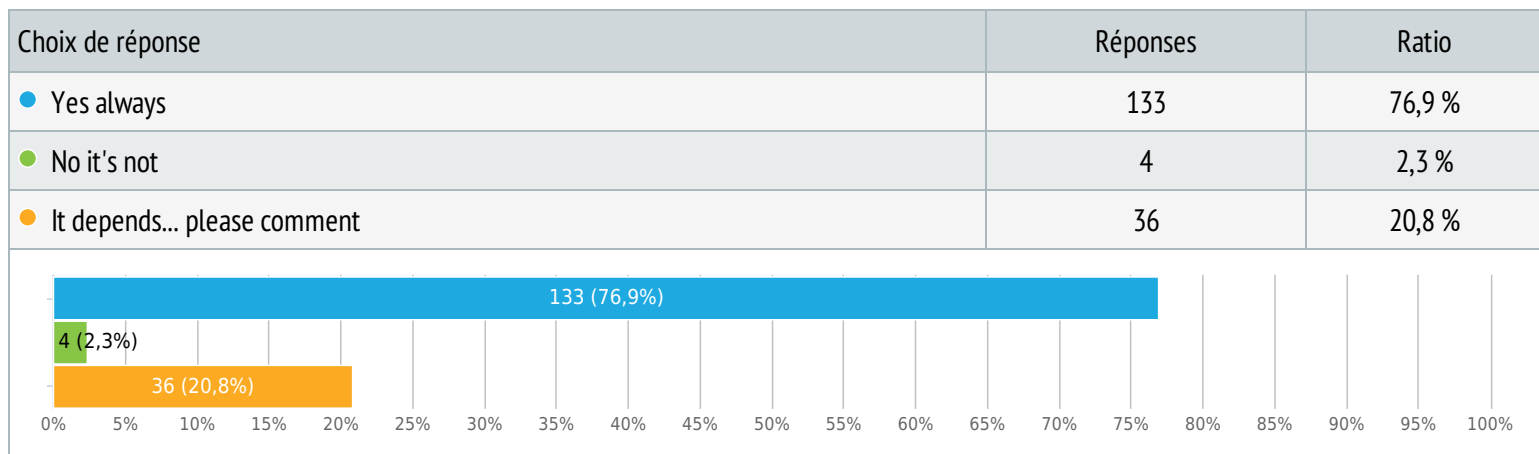


- Depends on the Object: no object = no sin. If object is neighbor's wife, porn, = sin is klar

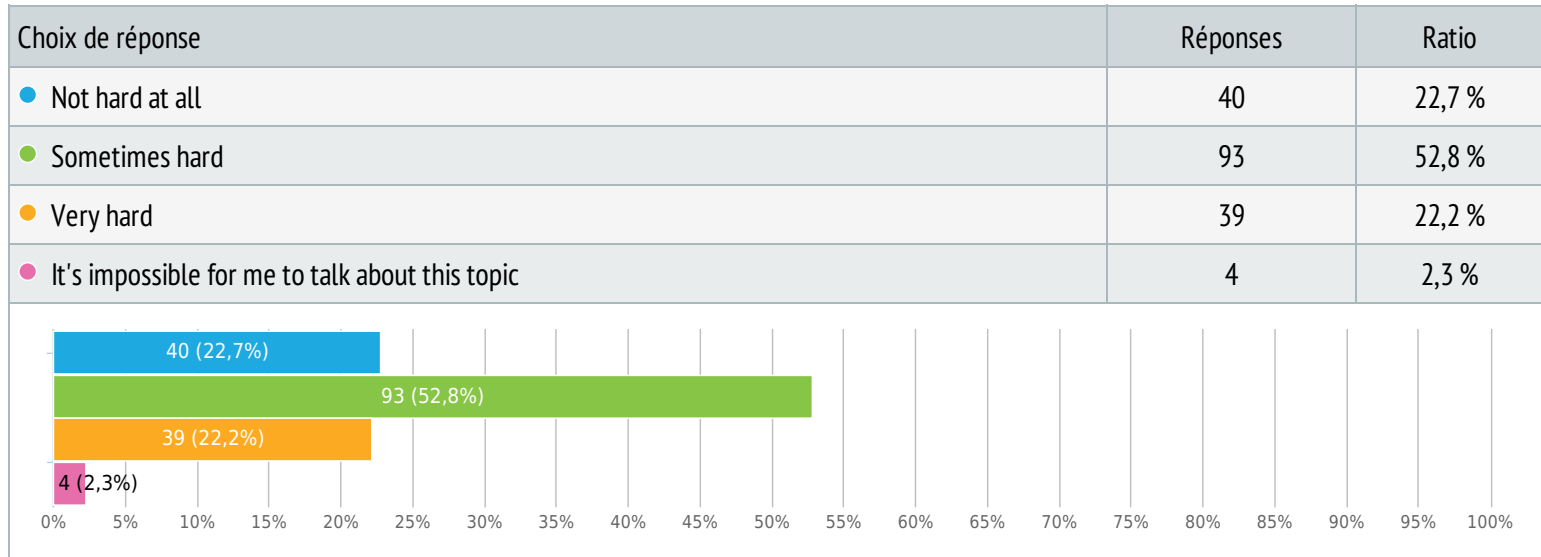

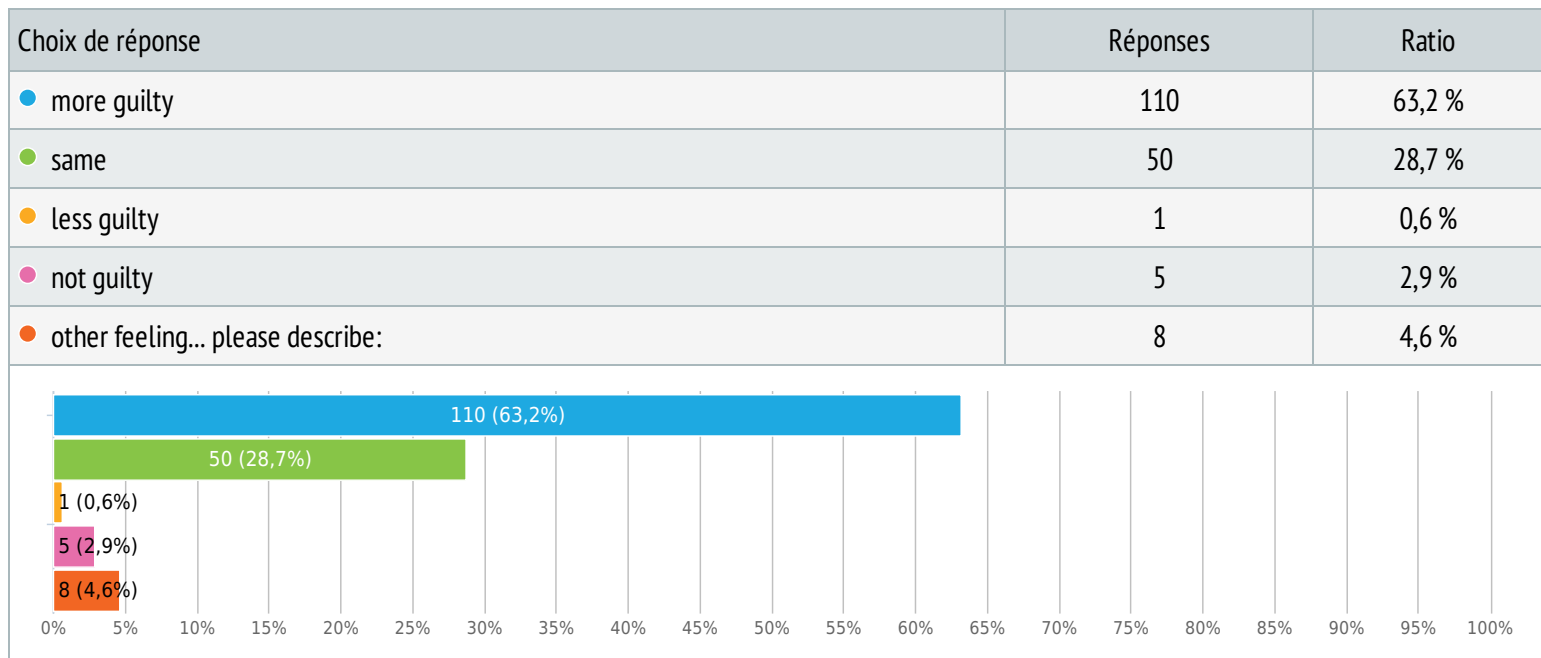
24. Do you find it hard to talk about your sexuality with your friends in the church?

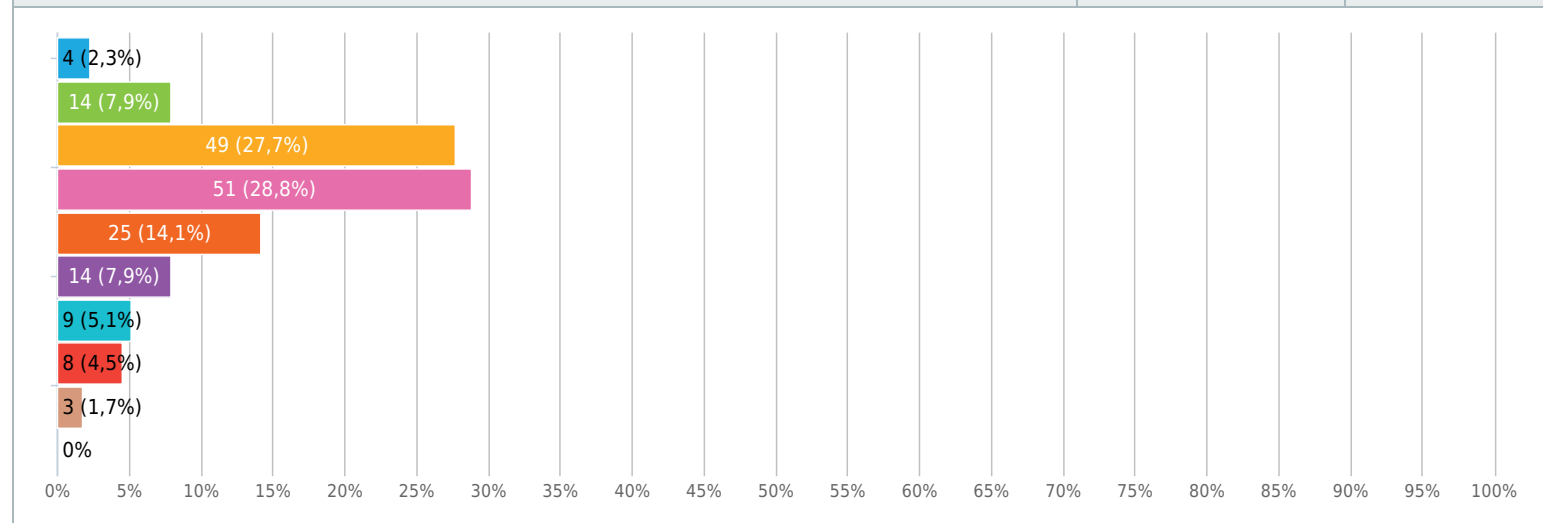
